1. We are all sinners!

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

2. There is a cost for your sin!

1 Yoana 5:12 Dini eyakar Lokoku, eyakar akiyar na; njini nyeyakar Lokoku ka Akuj, nyeyakar akiyar.

1 Yoana 3:15 Ituņanan daadaņ ęini itidiņit lokaato keņ, erae ięes ekaaran ka iyenete iyes atemar emam ekaaran ęolo erubakini eyakar akiyar ęina nyedaun tooma keņ.

3. Jesus died and paid for our sins on the cross!

Christ died for sinners!

1 Yoana 4:2-3 Epite lo iyenuniata iyes Etau ęolo ka Akuj: ituņanan daadaņ ęini elimori atemar abu Yesu Kristo bu erae ituņanan, erae ięes ęini ka Akuj. Nai ituņanan daadaņ ęini nyelimori Yesu, nyerae ięes ęini ka Akuj. Erae ituņanan ęin emoit ęolo a Kristo ęolo ipotu iyes kiirasi atemar ebunit ka eyai tokona nakwap.

1 Yoana 5:11 Alimoreť ięes na: Ikiinak Akuj iwon akiyar ęina nyedaun ka ebunit akiyar na aneni a Lokoku keņ.

4. We must put our faith and trust in Christ alone!

1 Yoana 5:14-15 Ikiyakar iwon atitinyu alokiņaren Akuj, anerae ikikinyomit iwon atemar, ani kikiņit iwon ibore daadaņ ęini ejok anacamit keņ, ikiirari ięes iwon. Ikwaņina ikiyenia iwon atemar ikiiranari ięes iwon ęinapaki ikiņisya idiobore daadaņ, ikiyeni daņ atemar, ikiinakini iwon ibore ęini ikiņita aneni keņ.

Diromanin 10:9-10, 13 Ani kilimu ka akituk kon atemar, "Erae Yesu Ekapolon" ka tonup alotau kon atemar abu Akuj kiteyaru ięes alokatwak, iun iyoņ. Anerae ikinupit iwon alotai yok, ido ikituruwor ęulu ikiyookino alokiņaren Akuj; ikilimu iwon a ęakitukwa yok, ido ikiun. Ikwapei ebaakatar Đakigireta ebe, "Đinituņanan ilipi alokiro a ęolo ke Ekapolon, eiun."

If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. God said if you receive and trust in Jesus Christ you are saved. Notice it does NOT say you "might" or "could" be saved — but "shall be saved". **YOU ARE SAVED!**
