Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

Yoana 14:6 Tolimok Yesu Tomas tema, "Arae Ayoŋ erot, Arae ŋuna a kire ka Arae akiyar; nyepedori ituŋanan abunore neni a Papa, mati kitoru neni kaŋ.

Yoana 3:17 Anerae pa eyakuunit Akuj Lokoku keŋ atubokin akwap, nai ikotere eunio akwap aŋuna keŋ.

Yoana 1:10,12 Ayai Akirot nakwap, tosub Akuj akwap aneni keŋ, nai nyeyenuna akwap iŋes. Nai ŋulu daadaŋ apotu kijaut iŋes, tonupa ekiro keŋ, abu iŋes inak ikes apedor ŋina ruworet ŋidwe ŋulu ka Akuj.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Yoana 6:47 Akalimokini ayoŋ iyes kire atemar, ŋini enupi, eryamuni akiyar ŋina nyedaun.

Yoana 10:28 Ainakini ayon ikes akiyar nina nyedaun, nyebukorosi ikes jik, emam dan nini ekopori ikes anakan kan.
