Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

Yohana 3:19 Atubokino ijes na ebe: abu akica bu nakwap, nai aminasi n̄it̄uḡa akiryonut akilo akica, anerae aroko n̄una etiyaete ikes.



We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

Yoana 6:40 N̄una ecamit Papa kaḡ ikes nu: n̄ini eanyuni ka tonup Lokoku, erylami akiyar n̄ina nyedaun. Eteyaruni ayon̄ ijes Akolon̄it̄ n̄ina esidyon̄.”

Yoana 3:18 Ijes n̄ini enupi Lokoku ka Akuj, nyetubokinio; n̄ini nyenupi, etubokinitae sek, anerae nyenupit̄ ijes ekiro a a Lokoku ka Akuj a n̄olo donupei.

Yoana 3:36 Nini enupi Lokoku, ijes eyakar akiyar njina nyedaun; njini nyepupi Lokoku, nyeryamuni akiyar njin, nai eyai anyunyura njina ka Akuj neni keŋ.”



There is a cost for sin!

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

Yoana 14:6 Tolimok Yesu Tomas tema, “Arae Ayoŋ erot, Arae njuna a kire ka Arae akiyar; nyepedori ituŋanan abunore neni a Papa, mati kitoru neni kaŋ.

Yoana 3:17 Anerae pa eyakuunit Akuj Lokoku keŋ atubokin akwap, nai ikotere eunio akwap aŋuna keŋ.

Yoana 1:10,12 Ayai Akirot nakwap, tosub Akuj akwap aneni keŋ, nai nyeyenuna akwap ijes. Nai njulu daadan apotu kijaut ijes, tonupa ekiro keŋ, abu ijes inak ikes apedor njina ruworet njidwe njulu ka Akuj.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God’s word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! It's realizing there is absolutely nothing whatsoever you can do to save yourself and *completely* trusting in Jesus Christ to save you! It's not any church that saves. It's not any baptism, not good works, not sacraments, not repenting, not praying through, not living a good life — **IT'S NOT ANYTHING YOU CAN DO!**

Niticisyo 4:12 Emam aiuno aneni a ice a daadan, anerae emam ekiro ece anakwap a daadan njolo einit Akuj njituŋa, njolo epedoryata njituŋa aiunor.”

Diepesoi 2:8-9 Anerae erae aŋuna ka ajokis a njina ka Akuj ikiunere iyes, aiuno njina ipotu iyes toryamut ananupit kus. Meere aŋuna a njiticisyo kus ikiunere iyes, nai erae aiuno ainakinet njina ka Akuj, ikotere nyiturokin idiotuŋanan aŋuna ka ainakinet a njin.

Tito 3:5 abu ijes iku iwon. Pa arae aŋuna a njiticisyo a njidi a njulu ajokak a njulu ikitiyat iwon, nai arae aŋuna ka akisyon keŋ ka alope abunio ijes ikiunia iwon. Abu ijes iku iwon, ikitesegu iwon anakidouno a njina a njaarei ka

ikituruwo iwon ɲulu kitet aneni ke Etau a ɲolo Asekan.

5. You must believe on the Lord and you will have everlasting life!

Yoana 5:24 “Akalmokini ayonɲ iyes kire atemar, ɲini iirari akaakiro, ido tonup ɲes ɲolo ekeyakuunit ayonɲ, eyakar akiyar ɲina nyedaun, nyetubokinio ɲes, nai alunyar ɲes anawanare nakiyar.”

Yoana 6:47 Akalmokini ayonɲ iyes kire atemar, ɲini enupi, erylamuni akiyar ɲina nyedaun.

Yoana 10:28 Ainakini ayonɲ ikes akiyar ɲina nyedaun, nyebukorosi ikes jik, emam daɲ ɲini ekopori ikes anakan kaɲ.



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. It is only trusting in Jesus Christ that can provide forgiveness of sins. This prayer is simply a way to express to God your faith in Him and thank Him for providing for your forgiveness.
