Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

Johannes 3:19 Ndelenee etokolo oleli: ouyelele we uya mounyuni, ndelenee ovanhu va li ve hole omulaulu komesho youyelele, osheshi oilonga yavo oii.

OVAROMA 3:23 Osheshi aveshe ova nyona, novehe noshinge shaKalunga,



We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

Johannes 6:40 Osheshi ehalo laTate oleli: Keshe tuu ou ta mono Omona ndele te mu itavele, oye e nomwenyo waalushe; ndele Ame handi mu nylumuna efiku laxuuninwa.”

Johannes 3:18 Ou te mu itavele, ye ita tokolwa; ndelenee ou ita itavele, ye okwa tokolwa nale, osheshi ye ina itavela edina IOmona Ewifa laKalunga.

Johannes 3:36 Ou ta itavele Omona, oye e nomwenyo waalushe; ndelenee ou iha dulika kOmona, ita ka mona omwenyo, ndelenee ehandu laKalunga otali kala kombada yaye.”



There is a cost for sin!

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

Johnannes 14:6 Jesus okwe mu nyamukula: “Aame ondjila noshili nomwenyo; kape na ou te uya kuTate, ngeenge hamwaame ta pitile.

Johannes 3:17 Osheshi Kalunga ina tuma Omona waye mounyuni a tokole onyuni, ndelenee onyuni u xupifwe kuye.

Johannes 1:10, 12 Oye okwa kala mounyuni, nounyuni owa shitwa kuye, nounyuni inau mu dimbulukwa. Ndelenee aveshe ava ve mu tambula, okwe va pa eenghono, va ninge ovana vaKalunga, ava hava itavele edina laye.

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God’s word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! It's realizing there is absolutely nothing whatsoever you can do to save yourself and *completely* trusting in Jesus Christ to save you! It's not any church that saves. It's not any baptism, not good works, not sacraments, not repenting, not praying through, not living a good life — **IT'S NOT ANYTHING YOU CAN DO!**

5. You must believe on the Lord and you will have everlasting life!

Johannes 5:24 “Oshilishili handi mu lombwele: Ou ta udu eendjovo dange, nota itavele ou a tuma nge, oku na omwenyo waalushe, ye ita ka tokolwa, ndelenee ye okwa dja mo mefyo, ndele e uya momwenyo.

Johannes 6:47 “Oshilishili handi mu lombwele: Ou ta itavele oku na omwenyo waalushe.

Johannes 10:28 Ndele Ame ohandi di pe omwenyo waalushe, ndele do itadi ka kana fiyo alushe, ndele kape na ou te di vakula mo meke lange.

Johnannes 20:31 Ndele ei oya shangwa, nye mu itavele Jesus Oye Kristus, Omona waKalunga, ndele moku mu itavela mu kale mu na omwenyo medina laye.



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. It is only trusting in Jesus Christ that can provide forgiveness of sins. This prayer is simply a way to express to God your faith in Him and thank Him for providing for your forgiveness.



"Lord,

I know that I am a sinner. I know that I deserve the consequences of my sin which is death and hell. However, I am trusting in Jesus Christ as my Savior. I believe that His death and resurrection provided for my forgiveness. I trust in Jesus and Jesus alone as my personal Lord and Savior. Thank you Lord, for saving me and forgiving me! Amen!"

If you just prayed that prayer — according to the Word of God — YOU ARE SAVED! HALLELUJAH!

You say, but I don't feel any different. Guess what? Your salvation does not depend on your feeling. **It ALL depends on doing what God SAID!**

God said if you receive and trust in Jesus Christ you are saved. Notice it does NOT say you "might" or "could" be saved — but "shall be saved". **YOU ARE SAVED!**

Osheshi: "Keshe tuu ou ta ifana edina lOmwene, oye ota xupifwa." OVAROMA 10:13

Didn't you just believe on the Lord Jesus Christ? Look at what John 3:36 says! It says you **HATH EVERLASTING LIFE!** Not "maybe" or "hope so" — **BUT HATH — YOU ARE SAVED!**
