Why did Jesus die?

1. Man by nature does evil (wrong).

It is not hard to admit that we all have done things that we know is wrong, but yet we do them anyway. That is called sin! We all are guilty of it we have been doing it since we were born.

Johana 3:19 Naa ena enkiguana, eewuo ewang'an enkop, kake etonyorra iltung'ana enaimin aaitalang ewang'an amu ai torrok iasat enye.

We are all sinners!

2. By that nature we are condemned.

There is a cost for sin!

3. Jesus was in the world and he died for us.

Johana 14:6 Nejoki Yesu ninye, “Ara nanu enkoitoo o esipata, o enkishui. Metii oltung'ani olotu enetii Papa mme nanu

Johana 3:17 Amu eitu erriu Enkai Enkerai enye enkop, meeu aiguanare enkop, kake pee etum enkop atajeunye.

Johana 1:10, 12 Netii ninye enkop, naa te ninye eitaa Enkai enkop, neitu eyiolou enkop ninye. Kake ore lelo pooki ootang'amutua ninye lelo ooiruko enkarna enye, neishoo engolon naakunye nkera e Nkai,

4. Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! It's realizing there is absolutely nothing whatsoever you can do to save yourself and *completely* trusting in Jesus Christ to save you! It's not any church that saves. It's not any baptism, not good works, not sacraments, not repenting, not praying through, not living a good life — **IT'S NOT ANYTHING YOU CAN DO!**

Johana 5:24 Esipa, esipa, ajoki intae, ore oloining'u ororei lai, neiruk ilo laairriwua, eeta enkishui oo ntarasi, nemejing enkiguana, kake etupukuo te keeya ajing atua enkishui.

Johana 6:47 Esipa, esipa, ajoki intae, ore olaairuk nanu eeta enkishui nemeish.

Johana 10:28 naa kaisho ninche enkishui nemeish, nemeimin ninche ntarasi, nemetii olaaidim aikonyarie ninche aitung'uaa enkaina ai.

Yohane 20:31 kake etisiraki kuna pee itumutumu aairuko nchere ore Yesu ninye Kristo, Enkerai e Nkai, naa tenirukuruku, nitumutumu enkishui tiatua enkarna enye.



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. It is only trusting in Jesus Christ that can provide forgiveness of sins. This prayer is simply a way to express to God your faith in Him and thank Him for providing for your forgiveness.



"Lord,

I know that I am a sinner. I know that I deserve the consequences of my sin which is death and hell. However, I am trusting in Jesus Christ as my Savior. I believe that His death and resurrection provided for my forgiveness. I trust in Jesus and Jesus alone as my personal Lord and Savior. Thank you Lord, for saving me and forgiving me! Amen!"

If you just prayed that prayer — according to the Word of God — YOU ARE SAVED! HALLELUJAH!

You say, but I don't feel any different. Guess what? Your salvation does not depend on your feeling. **It ALL depends on doing what God SAID!**

God said if you receive and trust in Jesus Christ you are saved. Notice it does NOT say you "might" or "could" be saved — but "shall be saved". **YOU ARE SAVED!**
