II There is a cost for that sin!

Christ died for sinners!

IV Salvation is a free gift, not by good works. You must take God's word for it, and trust Jesus alone!

Salvation is trusting and receiving Jesus Christ as your Savior. It's trusting in the fact that Jesus Christ died on the cross of Calvary to pay for your sins! It's realizing there is absolutely nothing whatsoever you can do to save yourself and *completely* trusting in Jesus Christ to save you! It's not any church that saves. It's not any baptism,

not good works, not sacraments, not repenting, not praying through, not living a good life — IT'S NOT ANYTHING YOU CAN DO!

V You must put our faith and trust in Christ in order to be saved.

Roma 4:24 kake enkaraki sii ninche iyiook ilooiruk ilo oitopiwuo Yesu Kristo Olaitoriani lang too lootuata,

Roma 10:9-10, 13 amu ti nimbalye iyie te nkutuk ino nchere ninye Olaitoriani Yesu niruk sii to Itau nchere eitopiwuo Enkai ninye aitung'uaa ilootuata, nikintajeuni. Amu to Itau eiruk oltung'ani neaku te ina eishori sipat, nelimu te nkutuk enye neitajeuni te ina. Amu, “Ore pooki ng'ae oipot enkarna o Laitoriani naa neitajeuni.”



If you want to accept Jesus Christ as your Savior and receive forgiveness from God, here is prayer you can pray. Saying this prayer or any other prayer will not save you. It is only trusting in Jesus Christ that can provide forgiveness of sins. This prayer is simply a way to express to God your faith in Him and thank Him for providing for your forgiveness.

"Lord,

I know that I am a sinner. I know that I deserve the consequences of my sin, which is death and hell. However, I am trusting in Jesus Christ as my Savior. I believe that His death and resurrection provided for my forgiveness. I trust in Jesus and Jesus alone as my personal Lord and Savior. Thank you Lord, for saving me and forgiving me! Amen!"

If you just prayed that prayer — according to the Word of God — YOU ARE SAVED! HALLELUJAH!

You say, but I don't feel any different. Guess what? Your salvation does not depend on your feeling. **It ALL depends on doing what God SAID!**

God said if you receive and trust in Jesus Christ you are saved. Notice it does NOT say you "might" or "could" be saved — but "shall be saved". **YOU ARE SAVED!**

Didn't you just believe on the Lord Jesus Christ? Look at what John 3:36 says! It says you **HATH EVERLASTING LIFE!** Not "maybe" or "hope so" — **BUT HATH — YOU ARE SAVED!**
